Enjoy the remaining weeks of tracking hope to see you all at the AGM





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Evacuation Procedure

In the event of a Fire Emergency please take the following steps

Trainers

Round up your group. If laying or working tracks they must stop immediately and follow you to our entry gate (where we meet in the mornings) and please sign out (or remove your 'entry' flag) before you leave so you can be accounted for.

On trial days the same applies only judges will be in charge of their individual groups of people and once everyone is together to proceed to morning tea area and then move to our entry gate and to be checked out before you leave.

Please always let Chief Steward know if you are training on trial days and where you will be.

Someone will drive around tooting their car horn. This is your signal to immediately stop what ever you are doing and follow the above steps.

In the event of a Medical Emergency

On training days.

One of our First Aid officers will be on duty and will phone an ambulance if required.

Someone will be sent down to our entry point to meet the ambulance. This person will have the location of the medical emergency to guide the ambulance.



On trial days (Saturday, Sunday or Wednesday).

All judges and stewards to make sure they have Chief Steward's number in their phone.

1. Dog Control

- Dogs to be on lead at all times.
- No members' dog or dogs shall be off-lead during official training sessions unless being trained and supervised by an instructor.
- Permission may be given by an instructor/official to run your dog off lead, in a specific area.
- No dogs off lead within 50m of base camp.
- Put your dog back on lead 50m prior to returning to your vehicles.
- Dogs must not be left "tethered" to the "outside" of vehicles at any time.
- Vehicles left with the backs open (eg hatchbacks) dogs must be secured.
- Any member not complying with a Request to place their dog back on lead, by a Committee member or instructor, shall be disciplined at the Committee's discretion.
- Members' dogs are not permitted to chase or harass livestock or wildlife.

2. Training

- The person authorized by the Committee may order the removal from the training session of any dog or handler whose conduct is objectionable.
- The Committee shall be empowered to discipline any handler who willfully interferes with another member's training, or another member's dog, or whose behaviour is objectionable.
- Any instances related to the above should be reported to the Committee in writing, within 7 days of the incident.
- Keep to allocated areas
 - For safety reasons the Training Co-ordinator needs to know where you are.
- Access to Gnangara: Check the website and Facebook for regular up-dates.
- **3.** All members are expected to volunteer assistance in line with the Club's statement of purposes and to participate as much as possible in Club activities (i.e. Morning Tea).
- **4.** Members should ensure that they remove all rubbish and keep tracking areas clean.
- **5.** Members shall take all reasonable steps to maintain cordial relationships with other legitimate users of tracking areas.

6. Vehicle Safety

- Please slow to 20km/hr when passing people, dogs or parked vehicles.
- Keep to the left and slow down when approaching the crest of a hill.


7. Spectators

Spectators must get the permission of the competitor and the Judge prior to following up a track.

8. Trialing

Treats for your dog at the end of track are to be in a sealed container within a sealed bag with your name and dog's name written clearly. Treat to be given to the Judge or their steward and not to be carried on the track.

- **9.** Any member who misappropriates, damages or causes loss or breakage of the Club's property shall forthwith make good any loss or breakages the Committee may direct.
- 10. Club joining fees and membership fees are non-refundable.
